



Member Code of Conduct

- 1. Be nice..."Golden Rule" please treat others the way you want to be treated.**
- 2. All members are expected to maintain proper decorum and to an atmosphere of friendship and relaxation and to show proper respect to fellow members, their guests and employees. Therefore, abusive, profane, or vulgar language or actions will not be tolerated.**
- 3. Proper attire for all when entering the clubhouse.**
 - A. No tank tops**
 - B. No bathing suits**
 - C. No exceptions**
 - D. Slacks jeans appropriate shorts etc. are allowed if appropriate for the time of day and atmosphere of event.**
- 4. Shoes, sandals, or similar footwear are required at all times.**
- 5. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests and children.**
- 6. Persons under the age of 21 are not allowed to sit or stand at the bar unless they are SBYC employees who serve alcoholic beverages to members.**
- 7. Bartenders have the legal right and obligation to refuse to serve anyone whom they consider to have drunk in excess. Bartenders are the representatives of the board in this regard and can report club members to the board for appropriate action.**
- 8. Food and/or drink from outside sources are not permitted in the clubhouse or on the patio while club food is being served.**
- 9. Animals, excluding service animals, are not permitted in the club or on its grounds other than as specified in the other SBYC policies concerning them.**
- 10. Smoking is limited to the designated smoking area and is strictly prohibited in the clubhouse under any circumstances.**
- 11. Soliciting funds, selling raffle tickets, or other such fundraising gestures are not allowed without the express permission of the board.**
- 12. These rules are not all inclusive, but are intended to be a guide to expected behavior.**
